1. FORMFOX SUSPENDED COLLECTION PROCESS

1.1. Enhancement Overview

This enhancement allows for improved 'Unable to Obtain' and 'Temperature Out of Range' collection processing. Once a collection is placed into one of these two statuses and suspended, the collection site can not create a new order for the same donor until the suspended order is closed or deleted.

This will eliminate the issues of suspended collection records providing an expired or completed status because FormFox forces the collector to finish the order if it is in a suspended status for the two reasons mentioned or FormFox auto-closed these collections at 5 hours and 1 second.

1.1.1. Shy Bladder Process

Figure 1 - The collection process begins and can be suspended when the collector selects the Unable to Obtain – Suspend Test – Donor Refuse button.




Figure 2 - The collection is suspended.




Figure 3 – At 5 hours and 1 second, if the collection is still in the suspended status, is auto-closed. If the results are not reviewed by an MRO, then the status is Unable. If the status is reviewed by the MRO, then they will provide a complete status.





Figure 4 – This will show as Unable in QIS if not reviewed by an MRO.



1.1.2. Temperature Out of Range Process

Figure 1 – The collection is suspended for temperature out of range.



Figure 2 – The specimen is out of temperature range and the collection suspends the collection until the DER is contacted and the donor is instructed to wait.

If another specimen (radio button one and two in Figure 1) is required and the donor leaves before another specimen is collected, then at 5 hours and 1 second the collection auto-closes and the status if the MRO does not review the results is Unable.





Figure 3 – The status of Unable shall display in QIS if the results are not review by an MRO.

There are no error messages displayed to the user in FormFox or QIS as these status change and auto-close is system generated.

2. QIS AUTHORIZATION FORM DISPLAYS BAT

2.1. Enhancement Overview

This enhancement allows a user in QIS to create a drug and breath alcohol test (BAT) order and the authorization form will display both drug and BAT tests in the Services To Be Performed section.

Note: The BAT will only display on the authorization form if the collection site provides this service. If the site does not perform BAT, then the BAT will not display in the Services to be Performed section.

Figure 1 – Create a drug and breath alcohol test in QIS with a collection site that performs BAT.





Figure 2 – Note the QIS generated Authorization form displays both the drug and BAT tests in the Service(s) to be Performed section.

3. ASSISTANT PRO (APRO) RANDOM SELECTIONS PUSH THROUGH QIS TO FORMFOX

3.1. Enhancement Overview

The random selections that populate QIS with this enhancement will automatically populate FormFox. The collection site and order expiration shall be open, so any site can search and locate an order.
